Letter dated 27 August 2008 from the Permanent Representative of Georgia to the United Nations addressed to the President of the Security Council

I have the honour of writing to you in your capacity as the President of the Security Council for the month of August 2008, in accordance with Article 35 (1) of the Charter of the United Nations, to ask you to convene a meeting of the Security Council on 28 August 2008, with the participation of the representative of Georgia, in order to consider the illegal unilateral actions of the Russian Federation with regard to two Georgian provinces (Abkhazia and South Ossetia) in violation of the Charter, all Security Council resolutions on Georgia, fundamental norms and principles of international law, the Helsinki Final Act, the six-point accord and the sovereignty, independence and territorial integrity of Georgia. It would be appreciated if the format of the meeting would be made public.
