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LETTER DATED 17 MAY 1989 FROM THE CHARGE D'AFFAIRES A.I.
OF THE PERMANENT MISSION OF THE ISLAMIC REPUBLIC OF IRAN
TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

Upon instructions from my Government and pursuant to my letter dated 15 May 1989, (S/20632), I have the honour to inform you of further violations of the cease-fire by Iraqi forces. The numerical sequence of violations follows the sequence in the said letter.

1521. At 0930 hours on 7 April 1989, 20 Iraqis were building six offensive barricades and digging canals at the geographic coordinates of NC 534-512 on the map of Sumar.

1522. At 1130 hours on 7 April 1989, five Iraqis were digging interconnecting canals at the geographic coordinates of ND 217-679 on the map of Ghasr-e-Shirin.

1523. At 1145 hours on 7 April 1989, eight Iraqis were digging canals at the geographic coordinates of QA 86-28 on the map of Einkhosh.

1524. From 1300 to 1600 hours on 7 April 1989, 12 Iraqis were building two offensive barricades at the geographic coordinates of NC 514-538 on the map of Sumar.

1525. From 1330 to 1425 hours on 7 April 1989, Iraqi personnel, using a loader, built up three trenches 10 metres in length and 1.5 m in height within the geographic coordinates of NC 512-549, NC 507-558 and NC 504-561 on the map of Sumar.

1526. At 1400 hours on 7 April 1989, tank platforms were built with a loader at the geographic coordinates of NC 512-549, NC 513-554 and NC 504-554 on the map of Sumar.

1527. At 1500 hours on 7 April 1989, 60 Iraqis were repairing offensive barricades in the vicinity of the geographic coordinates of NC 515-551 on the map of Sumar.

1528. At 1720 hours on 7 April 1989, a tank was moved from the geographic coordinates of QB 018-175 on the map of Dehloran and stationed at the geographic coordinates of QB 018-184 on the same map.

1529. At 1930 hours on 7 April 1989, five Iraqis stationed a Dushkka missile launcher on Height 1500 at the geographic coordinates of NE 329-903 on the map of Panjwein.

1530. On 7 April 1989, 17 Iraqis were digging a 12 m canal at the geographic coordinates of NC 468-579 on the map of Sumar.

1531. On 7 April 1989, Iraqis fired a bullet at Iranian forces near Pol-e-Be'sat at the geographic coordinates of TP 15-66 on the map of Nahr-e-Alishir.

1532. On 7 April 1989, five Iraqis were unloading material for constructing barricades and observation positions at the geographic coordinates of QB 017-213 on the map of Dehloran.

1533. From 0930 to 1520 hours on 8 April 1989, two loaders were excavating at the geographic coordinates of NC 42-55 on the map of Sumar.

1534. At 1000 on 8 April 1989, a bulldozer was in operation at the geographic coordinates of NC 465-565 on the map of Sumar.

1535. At 1150 hours on 8 April 1989, 40 Iraqis were building nine offensive barricades and digging a 100 m canal at the geographic coordinates of NC 514-553 on the map of Sumar.

1536. At 1200 hours on 8 April 1989, four offensive barricades were being built at the geographic coordinates of NC 540-537 and NC 486-566 on the map of Sumar.

1537. From 1605 to 1700 hours on 8 April 1989, new barricades were being built and group tents were being erected at the geographic coordinates of PE 557-028 on the map of Marivan.

1538. At 1755 hours on 8 April 1989, a tank was stationed at the geographic coordinates of QA 968-257 on the map of Nahr-e-Anbar.

1539. At 1855 hours on 8 April 1989, new barricades were being built in the vicinity of the geographic coordinates of QB 979-248 and QB 160-220 on the map of Nahr-e-Anbar at the city of Dehloran.

1540. On 8 April 1989, a new barricade was built at the geographic coordinates of NE 655-674 on the map of Garmab.

1541. On 8 April 1989, a new depot was built at the geographic coordinates of NE 671-608 on the map of Garmab.

1542. On 8 April 1989, a new observation post was built at the geographic coordinates of NC 465-575 on the map of Sumar.

1543. On 8 April 1989, four new offensive barricades were built and an observation barricade was repaired at the geographic coordinates of NC 490-562 on the map of Sumar.

1544. On 8 April 1989, new canals and barricades were made at the geographic coordinates of NC 496-554 on the map of Sumar.

1545. On 8 April 1989, 24 new offensive barricades were built at the geographic coordinates of NC 487-563, NC 486-567, NC 488-562, NC 489-565, NC 484-567, NC 484-568, NC 483-569, NC 482-575 and NC 499-555 on the map of Sumar.

1546. On 8 April 1989, five offensive barricades were built at the geographic coordinates of NC 496-554 on the map of Sumar.

1547. On 8 April 1989, an 18 m canal was dug by 18 Iraqis at the geographic coordinates of NC 503-557 on the map of Sumar.

1548. On 8 April 1989, five Iraqis were stationed at the geographic coordinates of NF 5685-0485 on the map of Piranshahr.

1549. On 8 April 1989, a new base was built at the geographic coordinates of NF 6600-0470 on the map of Piranshahr. Iraqi forces also remarkably reinforced their other bases in Kink at the geographic coordinates of NF 6155-0235 on the map of Piranshahr and in Miyutan at the geographic coordinates of NF 5820-0470 in the area of Shiverash on the same map.

1550. At 0820 hours on 9 April 1989, some 15 to 20 barricades were being built and a 50 m canal was being dug at the geographic coordinates of NC 485-567 on the map of Sumar.

1551. From 0840 to 1220 hours on April 1989, 12 loaders were excavating at the geographic coordinates of NC 42-55 on the map of Sumar.

1552. At 1020 hours on 9 April 1989, 20 Iraqis were building barricades at the geographic coordinates of NC 466-553 on the map of Sumar.

1553. At 1100 hours on 9 April, four Iraqis were building barricades at the geographic coordinates of ND 22-66 on the map of Ghasr-e-Shirin.

1554. At 1100 hours on 9 April 1989, nine Iraqis were digging canals at the geographic coordinates of QA 997-238, QA 999-234 and QA 995-237 on the map of Dehloran.

1555. At 1500 hours on 9 April 1989, six Iraqis were building barricades at the geographic coordinates of PB 841-050 on the map of Salehabad.

1556. On 9 April 1989, a new barricade was built at the geographic coordinates of NE 658-682 on the map of Baneh.

1557. On 9 April 1989, two underground bunkers were built at the geographic coordinates of NE 647-685 on the map of Baneh.

1558. On 9 April 1989, three new barricades were built at the geographic coordinates of NE 645-687 on the map of Baneh.

1559. At 0840 hours on 10 April 1989, seven Iraqis were digging the ground at the geographic coordinates of QB 018-201 on the map of Dehloran.

1560. At 0915 hours on 10 April 1989, 15 Iraqis were digging canals at the geographic coordinates of NC 190-840 on the map of Halaleh.

1561. At 0940 hours on 10 April 1989, six Iraqis were building three offensive barricades at the geographic coordinates of NC 487-559 on the map of Sumar.

1562. At 1000 hours on 10 April 1989, 10 Iraqis were building barricades in the vicinity of the geographic coordinates of QA 54-54 on the map of Yebeis.

1563. At 1000 hours on 10 April 1989, 12 Iraqis were digging canals at the geographic coordinates of NC 468-579 on the map of Sumar.

1564. From 1030 to 1140 hours on 10 April 1989, a loader was building up a U-shaped trench in the vicinity of the geographic coordinates of NC 558-504 on the map of Sumar.

1565. At 1630 hours on 10 April 1989, 20 Iraqis were building barricades at the geographic coordinates of NE 398-911 and NE 384-897 on the maps of Marivan and Panjwein respectively.

1566. At 1804 hours on 10 April 1989, the Iraqis were digging the ground to construct barricades in the vicinity of the geographic coordinates of QA 997-238, QA 999-234 and QA 9950-2378 on the map of Dehloran.

1567. At 2115 hours on 10 April 1989, a total of 19 flare bullets and mortars and a large number of warning pistol shots were fired at the geographic coordinates of PB 69-08 on the map of Mehran. Furthermore, traffic of vehicles with their head-lights on was reported as unusual.

1568. On 10 April 1989, Iraqi forces reinforced their positions at the geographic coordinates of NF 574-027 on the map of Piranshahr.

1569. On 10 April 1989, an interconnecting barricade was built at the geographic coordinates of NE 637-878 on the map of Baneh.

1570. On 10 April 1989, Iraqi forces staged armored infantry manoeuvres with frequent explosions in the area between the geographic coordinates of TQ 28000-15500 and TQ 01000-14500 on the map of Hoseinieh station and Nud station.

1571. From 0830 to 1020 hours on 11 April 1989, 28 IFA vehicles, 9 patrol vans, 13 Ovaz vehicles, 4 Toyota vans carrying personnel, 6 IFAs carrying light equipment and heavy machine-guns, 3 IFA carrying ammunition, 1 empty Zil and 6 empty IFAs, all escorted by a patrol van, were heading from the Panjwein Dukan area to Garmak and Dukan and returned after discharging their personnel, ammunition and equipment.

1572. At 0850 hours on 11 April 1989, two IFA vehicles unloaded ammunition in the vicinity of the geographic coordinates of NB 99-98 on the map of Salehabad.

1573. At 0900 hours on 11 April 1989, six Iraqis were building two barricades in the vicinity of the geographic coordinates of NC 488-559 on the map of Sumar.

1574. At 1455 hours on 11 April 1989, a defensive barricade was being constructed in the vicinity of the geographic coordinates of PB 81-01 on the map of Salehabad.

1575. At 1535 hours on 11 April 1989, four Iraqis were building barricades at the geographic coordinates of ND 225-663 on the map of Ghasr-e-Shirin.

1576. At 1600 hours on 11 April 1989, five Iraqis were building an offensive barricade in the vicinity of the geographic coordinates of NC 424-573 on the map of Sumar.

It would be highly appreciated if this letter were circulated as a document of the Security Council.
