Sessional Committee I - first informal meeting

Item 4 Review of progress in the implementation of the Programme of Action for the Least Developed Countries for the Decade 2001–2010 (continued)

During the interactive debate, representatives of the following member States took the floor: Zimbabwe (on behalf of the Group of 77 and China); Peru (on behalf of the Group of Latin American and Caribbean States); Indonesia (on behalf of the Asian Group); France (on behalf of the European Union); European Commission; Bangladesh (on behalf of the least developed countries); China; Japan; Islamic Republic of Iran; Philippines; and Thailand.
