Appointment of members of the Joint Inspection Unit

Note by the Secretary-General

1. Article 4, paragraphs 2 and 3, of the statute of the Joint Inspection Unit

"Article 4

"1. ...

- "2. An Inspector elected to replace one whose term of office has not expired shall hold office for the remainder of that term, provided it is not less than three years. Otherwise the duration of the appointment will be for a full term.
- "3. An Inspector may resign on giving six months' notice to the Chairman of the Unit."
- 2. The Secretary-General has received from the Chairman of the Joint Inspection Unit notification of the resignation of Mr. Mark E. Allen (United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland), effective 21 September 1984, from the membership of the Unit. Accordingly, the General Assembly will be required, at the thirty-ninth session, to appoint a person to fill the unexpired portion of the term of office of Mr. Allen, i.e., until 31 December 1987.

3. As provided in article 3, paragraph 3, of the Unit's statute, the procedure for the replacement of the Inspectors whose terms of office have expired or who have resigned or otherwise ceased to be members of the Unit shall be governed by the provisions of paragraphs 1 and 2 of the same article, the text of which has been reproduced in document A/39/107.
