**Letter dated 13 October 2008 from the Permanent Representative
of the Democratic Republic of the Congo to the United Nations
addressed to the President of the Security Council**

On instructions from my Government, and further to my letter of 8 October 2008 (S/2008/641), I have the honour to transmit to you the following:

- (a) An inventory of objects abandoned by elements of the Rwandan Defence Forces (RDF) at the Rumangabo theatre of operations (see annex I);
- (b) A new series of photographs proving the involvement of Rwanda (see annex II).

While reiterating its submission of 8 October 2008, my Government requests that an investigation should be undertaken in order to explain why related military materiel intended for the Rwandan contingent that is serving as part of the African Union-United Nations Hybrid Operation in Darfur (UNAMID) should have been found in a military arena in the Democratic Republic of the Congo.

My Government once again invites the Security Council to take action on this request and would be grateful if you could arrange for this letter and its annexes to be circulated as a document of the Council.

An inventory of objects abandoned by elements of the Rwandan Defence Forces (RDF) at the Rumangabo theatre of operations

On the tenth day of October 2008, I, Major Cirimwami Nkuba, Warrant Officer T2, 8 Rgn Mil, itemized the objects that were abandoned by elements of the Rwandan Defence Forces (RDF) at Rumangabo on 9 October 2008, as follows:

(a) Arms

- R4 No. N 808245 A1 (RDF)
- AKA 47 NK 1825 (RDF)
- Grenade T 0985-3T (RDF)
- AKA 47 4161 belonging to Sergeant Nkurunziza Emmanuel (RDF)
- Electric detonator

(c) Communications equipment

- One PRC-710S Tadiran radio, 1747 series, found beside the body of Sergeant Nkurunziza Emmanuel (RDF) IBN Special Forces operator, who was found dead and was summarily buried at Rumangabo.

(d) Equipment

- One RDF rocket carrier belonging to soldier Niyomugabo Pierre of E-Coy (Company E of the IBN Special Forces)
- Five RDF uniforms
- Eleven RDF jackets
- Eight raincoats (property of Rwandan contingent to Darfur)
- Five RDF kepis
- Two further raincoats which could not be identified
- Five Webbs
- One plastic mess tin
- Two water bottles
- The insignia of Sergeant Nkurunziza Emmanuel, who was found dead and was summarily buried at Rumangabo.

15. A receipt dated 29 August 2008 issued upon the discharge from Kigali, Military Hospital, Rwanda (Tel. No. 586420) of Sergeant Nkurunziza Emmanuel.
16. Military medical insurance card belonging to Corporal Nkurunziza Emmanuel, born 1 January 1975, member No. 0044762-00, registration No. 4462, CSR No. 1026544T valid through 31 December 2007, issued by the Rwandan Ministry of Defence.
17. Military identity card No. 52828 belonging to Cpl. Nkurunziza Emmanuel. Height: 1.80 metres; weight: 60 kilograms; registration No. (AP) 4854, issued on 15 September 2003 by the Director of RDF registration.
18. Transfer document in the name of Cpl. Nkurunziza, service No. 44767, 1st. BN, Special Forces, issued on 30 July 2008 by the Rwandan Ministry of Defence in Nyabihu district and signed by Second Lieutenant Pascal Twagirayezu, RMO 1BN Special Forces (restricted).

Notes

- All the material evidence found at the Rumangabo theatre of operations was left behind by the Rwandan Defence Forces (RDF). No trace of the National Congress for the Defence of the People has yet been found.
- The evidence and the statements made by the local population sufficiently prove that Rumangabo was attacked by the First Battalion of the RDF Special Forces.
- Indications that the Burundian soldier Ruvuzimana Désiré was at Rumangabo, and that he entered Rwanda on 2 January 2008 and was registered by the immigration service, is further proof of the previously reported recruitment of Burundians by Rwanda to fight in the war in the Democratic Republic of the Congo.
- The RPA military identity card in the name of Cpl. Nkurunziza Emmanuel issued on 15 September 2003 bears his old RPA registration number (AP 4854).
- The flip side of the admission slip for the patient Nkurunziza Emmanuel bears the stamp of Dr. Christophe Seyinzoga.
