Views of the staff representatives of the United Nations Secretariat

Note by the Secretary-General

1. The Secretary-General transmits herewith, for consideration by the Fifth Committee, a document submitted pursuant to the provision set out in paragraph 2 (a) of General Assembly resolution 35/213, in which the Assembly reiterated its readiness to receive and consider fully the views of the staff as set out by a single recognized representative of the staff of the United Nations Secretariat in a document submitted through the Secretary-General under the agenda item on human resources management. The staff representative bodies have been unable to agree on a single representative to represent their views. I am therefore transmitting the views of the staff representatives of the United Nations Secretariat, as received by the Executive Office of the Secretary-General for transmission to the Assembly, in the two addenda to the present note.
