Note by the Secretary-General

The Secretary-General has received the following communication relating to the membership of the Sub-Commission on Prevention of Discrimination and Protection of Minorities and has the honour to transmit it to the Commission.

"With reference to item 6 (c) of the agenda of the eighteenth session of the Commission on Human Rights, I have the honour to inform you that, with the consent of the French Government, the representative of France in the Commission on Human Rights has decided to re-nominate Mr. Pierre Juvigny, Master of Requests of the Conseil d'Etat, for election to the Sub-Commission on Prevention of Discrimination and Protection of Minorities."
