Report of the Second Committee*

1. At its 2nd plenary meeting, on 19 September 2008, the General Assembly, on the recommendation of the General Committee, decided to include in the agenda of its sixty-third session the item entitled:

"Groups of countries in special situations:

- "(a) Third United Nations Conference on the Least Developed Countries;
- "(b) Specific actions related to the particular needs and problems of landlocked developing countries: outcome of the International Ministerial Conference of Landlocked and Transit Developing Countries and Donor Countries and International Financial and Development Institutions on Transit Transport Cooperation"

and to allocate it to the Second Committee.

2. The Second Committee held a substantive debate on the item at its 23rd and 24th meetings, on 3 and 4 November 2008. An account of the Committee's discussion of the item is contained in the relevant summary records (A/C.2/63/SR.23 and 24). Attention is also drawn to the general debate held by the Committee at its 2nd to 6th meetings, from 6 to 8 October (see A/C.2/63/SR.2-6). An account of the Committee's further consideration of the item will be provided in the addenda to the present report.
