LETTER DATED 7 MARCH 1984 FROM THE PIRMANING REPRESENTATIVE OF NORWAY ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE CONFIRENCE ON DISARMAMENT CONCERNING RULES 33 to 35 OF THE RULES OF PROCEDURE

Further to my letter of 9 lecember 1983 I wish to clarify that for the present Norway intends to, with reference to No. 33 of the rules of procedure, present working papers on chemical wempons and nuclear test ban during the 1984 mession and, with reference to Nos. 34 and 35 of the rules of procedures, to express views on these items in plenary meetings and in the subsidiary bodies concerned. Norway has also in the past participated in plenary meetings and in the Ad Hoc Working Groups on the following items:

- Effective international arrangements to assure non-nuclear-weapon States against the use or threat of use of nuclear weapons;
- Radiological Weapons;
- the Comprehensive Programme of Disarmament;

and is interested to continue to do so.
