#### **Annotations**

#### 1. Election of officers

Rule 15 of the rules of procedure of the functional commissions of the Economic and Social Council stipulates that, at the commencement of the first meeting of a regular session, the Commission shall elect from among the representatives of its members a Chairperson, one or more Vice-Chairpersons and such other officers as may be required. Following the established practice, the Commission shall elect a Chairperson and four Vice-Chairpersons and designate one of the Vice-Chairpersons also as Rapporteur (Vice-Chairperson-and-Rapporteur).

In accordance with subparagraph (c) of its decision 2002/210 of 13 February 2002, the Economic and Social Council decided that immediately following the closure of a regular session, the Commission for Social Development would hold the first meeting of its subsequent regular session for the sole purpose of electing the new Chairperson and other members of the Bureau. Consequently, the Commission held the first meeting of its forty-seventh session on 15 February 2008, immediately following the closure of the forty-sixth session, and elected by acclamation Kirsti Lintonen (Finland) as Chairperson of the Commission and Lilit Toutkhalian (Armenia), Tareq Md. Ariful Islam (Bangladesh) and Lorena Giménez (Bolivarian Republic of Venezuela) as Vice-Chairpersons.

The Group of African States subsequently nominated Soha Gendi (Egypt) to represent the regional group on the Bureau as Vice-Chairperson-elect. At the opening meeting of the forty-seventh session of the Commission, on 4 February 2009, the nominee will be elected as Vice-Chairperson. At the same meeting, the Commission will designate one of its Vice-Chairpersons also having rapporteurial responsibilities.

#### 2. Adoption of the agenda and other organizational matters

Rule 7 of the rules of procedure requires that, after the election of its officers at the beginning of each session, the Commission shall adopt the agenda for that session on the basis of the provisional agenda. The provisional agenda and documentation for the forty-seventh session of the Commission were approved by the Economic and Social Council in its decision 2008/244 of 24 July 2008.

The proposed organization of work of the Commission for Social Development at its forty-seventh session (see annex I) has been prepared pursuant to relevant decisions of the General Assembly and the Economic and Social Council to facilitate the consideration of agenda items within the time frame available and in accordance with the conference services allocated to the Commission. The timetable should be considered tentative and indicative: if the Commission completes its consideration of an item ahead of schedule, it may wish to proceed immediately to the next item.

The Commission is scheduled to meet from Wednesday, 4 February, to Friday, 13 February 2009. Arrangements have been made to hold morning and afternoon meetings during the session: morning meetings will be held from 10 a.m. to 1 p.m. and afternoon meetings from 3 p.m. to 6 p.m.

# 3. Follow-up to the World Summit for Social Development and the twenty-fourth special session of the General Assembly

In accordance with General Assembly resolution 55/46 on the implementation of the outcome of the World Summit for Social Development and of the twenty-fourth special session of the General Assembly entitled "World Summit for Social Development and beyond: achieving social development for all in a globalizing world", the Commission will undertake regular assessment of the implementation of the Copenhagen commitments and the further initiatives adopted at Geneva.

In its resolution 2008/19 of 24 July 2008, the Economic and Social Council decided that the theme for the 2009-2010 review and policy cycle would be "Social integration", taking into account its interrelationship with poverty eradication and full employment and decent work for all. The Commission will review the theme at its forty-seventh session in 2009. The Commission will have before it the report of the Secretary-General on the priority theme for the policy part of the 2009-2010 cycle.
