Letter dated 26 January 2009 from the Permanent Representative of Cuba to the United Nations addressed to the Secretary-General

I have the honour to refer to the summary statement of matters of which the Security Council is seized and of the stage reached in their consideration.

In accordance with the procedure established in the notes by the President of the Security Council dated 19 July 2006 (S/2006/507), 19 December 2007 (S/2007/749) and 31 December 2008 (S/2008/847), I should like to notify you that the Government of the Republic of Cuba requests that the following four items brought to the Council's attention by the Republic of Cuba remain on the list of matters of which the Security Council is seized:

- Letter dated 11 July 1960 from the Minister for Foreign Affairs of Cuba addressed to the President of the Security Council (S/4378);
- Letter dated 31 December 1960 from the Minister for Foreign Affairs of Cuba addressed to the President of the Security Council (S/4605);
- Complaint from Cuba (S/10993);
- Letter dated 2 February 1990 from the Permanent Representative of Cuba to the United Nations addressed to the President of the Security Council (S/21120).

I should be grateful if you would have this letter circulated as a document of the Security Council.
