The Working Group will continue its discussions on options for revising the Gothenburg Protocol. It will have before it the report on the fourteenth meeting of the Expert Group on Techno-economic Issues (Sorrento, Italy, 13-14 October 2008), the report on the workshop on the cost-benefit analysis of the Protocol (Gothenburg, Sweden, 27 June 2008), as well as a document presenting the options for revision of the Protocol and the plan for the revision of the Protocol prepared by the secretariat.

The Chair of the Task Force on Integrated Assessment Modelling will report on the results of the tutorial workshop on the GAINS model and the workshop on non-binding aspirational targets for emission reductions for the year 2050. The Parties are expected to provide information on progress with updating energy scenarios for the Protocol revision. The Working Group may also wish to discuss the most recent emission inventory data and modelling results presented by EMEP<sup>3</sup>, including the quality of the emission data for particulate matter (PM).

The Working Group on Effects will present recent information on the effects of air pollutants on the environment and human health, in particular due to PM. In addition, progress with regard to developing indicators such as on biodiversity, dynamic modelling and the implementation of the guidelines on reporting effects, will be described.

The Working Group will be informed about the preliminary results of the fifteenth meeting of the Expert Group on Techno-economic Issues, scheduled for 6 and 7 April 2009. The Working Group may wish to discuss, in particular, preliminary results on technical data for major stationary sources and emission limit values. It may also wish to review progress in the updating of best available techniques in the guidance documents to the Protocol.

## Item 4: Progress in the implementation of the Action Plan for Eastern Europe, Caucasus and Central Asia

**Tentative timing:** Wednesday, 22 April, afternoon

The Working Group may wish to proceed with discussions on options to increase the flexibility related to existing installations in countries of Eastern Europe, Caucasus and Central Asia (EECCA) and South-Eastern Europe (SEE), in order to help facilitate those countries' ratification of protocols. Delegates from EECCA and SEE countries in particular will be invited to share their problems and needs. Delegations will also be invited to provide information on specific actions taken to implement the Action Plan.
