Summary statement by the Secretary-General on matters of which the Security Council is seized and on the stage reached in their consideration

Addendum

Pursuant to rule 11 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, and in accordance with paragraph 7 of the note by the President dated 19 December 2007 (S/2007/749), the Secretary-General is submitting the following summary statement.

The complete list of items of which the Security Council was seized as at 1 November 2008 is contained in document S/2008/10/Add.43 of 7 November 2008.

The present addendum lists the items on which the Security Council took action during the week ending 29 November 2008. The dates given for each item indicate when the item was first taken up by the Council at a formal meeting, and the most recent formal meeting of the Council held on that item.

The situation in the Middle East, including the Palestinian question (3 October 2000; 25 November 2008)

The Security Council resumed its consideration of the item at its 6022nd meeting, held on 25 November 2008. Under rule 39 of its provisional rules of procedure, the Council extended an invitation to B. Lynn Pascoe, Under-Secretary-General for Political Affairs.

Meeting of the Security Council with the troop-contributing countries pursuant to resolution 1353 (2001), annex II, sections A and B (10 September 2001; 26 November 2008)

United Nations Organization Mission in the Democratic Republic of the Congo

The Security Council resumed its consideration of the item at its 6023rd meeting, held in private on 26 November 2008. At the close of the meeting, in accordance with rule 55 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, a communiqué was issued through the Secretary-General in place of a verbatim record (S/PV.6023).



The situation concerning the Democratic Republic of the Congo (29 May 1997; 26 November 2008)

The Security Council resumed its consideration of the item at its 6024th meeting, held on 26 November 2008. The Council, under rule 37 of its provisional rules of procedure, invited the representatives of the Democratic Republic of the Congo and Rwanda, at their request, to participate in the consideration of the item without the right to vote. Under rule 39 of its provisional rules of procedure, the Council extended an invitation to Alan Doss, Special Representative of the Secretary-General and Head of the United Nations Organization Mission in the Democratic Republic of the Congo.

Security Council resolutions 1160 (1998), 1199 (1998), 1203 (1998), 1239 (1999) and 1244 (1999) (5 November 1999; 26 November 2008)

The Security Council resumed its consideration of the item at its 6025th meeting, held on 26 November 2008. The Council, under rule 37 of its provisional rules of procedure, invited the representatives of Albania, Germany and Serbia, at their request, to participate in the consideration of the item without the right to vote. Under rule 39 of its provisional rules of procedure, the Council extended invitations to Lamberto Zannier, Special Envoy of the Secretary-General and Head of the United Nations Interim Administration Mission in Kosovo, and Skender Hyseni. The President, on behalf of the Council, made a statement (S/PRST/2008/44).
