

# Note by the Secretary-General

#### Addendum

- 1. The Secretary-General has received notification of the resignation of Thomas Thomma (Germany) from the Committee on Contributions effective April 2009. Accordingly, the General Assembly will be required to appoint, at its current session, a person to fill the vacancy for the remaining period of the term of office of Mr. Thomma, which expires on 31 December 2011.
- 2. The Government of Germany has nominated Gönke Roscher to fill the vacancy arising from the resignation of Mr. Thomma.
- 3. In a communication dated 1 May 2009, the Secretariat was informed by the Chairman of the Group of Western European and Other States that the candidature of Ms. Roscher has been endorsed by that Group.
