Letter dated 11 May 2009 from the Permanent Representative of the Islamic Republic of Iran to the United Nations addressed to the President of the Security Council

I wish to inform you that my delegation categorically rejects the baseless allegations raised against, and the irrelevant and unwarranted references made to, the Islamic Republic of Iran by David Miliband, Secretary of State for Foreign and Commonwealth Affairs of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland, in today's meeting of the Security Council on the Middle East.

Undoubtedly, the United Kingdom, which has played a big role in the last six decades in creating the sufferings and the misery of the Palestinian people through its support for the Israeli regime and through its complicity in the crimes committed by the said regime against the Palestinians and other Arab nations in the region, is not at all in a position to render judgement on others' intentions and policies.

We believe that the said baseless allegations and unwarranted references that were made against Iran by the United Kingdom in today's meeting are certainly aimed at distracting the international community's attention from the Israeli crimes in the region and from the responsibilities that the said regime's supporters, particularly the United Kingdom, have in this regard.

I would be grateful if you could bring the present letter to the attention of the members of the Council and circulate it as a document of the Security Council.
