Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 751 (1992) concerning Somalia

Note verbale dated 8 May 2009 from the Permanent Mission of Lithuania to the United Nations addressed to the Chairman of the Committee

The Permanent Mission of the Republic of Lithuania to the United Nations presents its compliments to the Chairman of the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 751 (1992) and, according to the provisions of paragraph 25 of resolution 1844 (2008), has the honour to convey the following information.

Regarding arms embargoes, Somalia is included in the list of the States to which the export or transit of the goods listed in the common military list is prohibited and for which brokering in negotiations and transactions in the goods listed in the common military list is prohibited. This list is adopted by Governmental resolution No. 237 which has been in force since 1 March 2005.

On 16 February 2009, the Council of the European Union adopted Common Position 2009/138/CFSP concerning restrictive measures against Somalia. After designation of the persons subject to political sanctions, they are immediately included in the national list of the persons to whom the entry into, or transit through, the territory of the Republic of Lithuania is prohibited. Financial sanctions are directly implemented upon the adoption of relevant regulations of the Council of the European Union.
