Board of Auditors

Report of the Fifth Committee

Rapporteur: Mr. Hamzah Mohammed HAMZAH (Syrian Arab Republic)

- 1. At its 11th meeting, on 9 October 1978, the Fifth Committee considered a note by the Secretary-General (A/33/123) concerning the vacancy in the membership of the Board of Auditors which will occur as a result of the expiration of the term of office of one of its members on 30 June 1979.
- 2. The members of the Fifth Committee were invited to make suggestions in regard to the country whose Auditor-General (or officer holding the equivalent title) might be recommended to the General Assembly for appointment as a member of the Board of Auditors. The Government of Ghana proposed its Auditor-General to fill the vacancy (A/C.5/33/16).
- 3. On the proposal of the Chairman, the Fifth Committee decided, without objection, to dispense with the secret ballot since there was one candidate for one vacancy.
- 4. The Fifth Committee then decided, by acclamation, to recommend the Auditor-General of Ghana for appointment as a member of the Board of Auditors for a three-year term beginning on 1 July 1979.

RECOMMENDATION OF THE FIFTH COMMITTEE

5. The Fifth Committee recommends that the General Assembly should appoint the Auditor-General of Ghana as a member of the Board of Auditors for a three-year term beginning on 1 July 1979.
