Board of Auditors

Report of the Fifth Committee

Rapporteur: Mr. Hamzah Mohammed HAMZAH (Syrian Arab Republic)

1. At its 11th meeting, on 9 October 1978, the Fifth Committee considered a note by the Secretary-General (A/33/123) concerning the vacancy in the membership of the Board of Auditors which will occur as a result of the expiration of the term of office of one of its members on 30 June 1979.
2. The members of the Fifth Committee were invited to make suggestions in regard to the country whose Auditor-General (or officer holding the equivalent title) might be recommended to the General Assembly for appointment as a member of the Board of Auditors. The Government of Ghana proposed its Auditor-General to fill the vacancy (A/C.5/33/16).
3. On the proposal of the Chairman, the Fifth Committee decided, without objection, to dispense with the secret ballot since there was one candidate for one vacancy.
4. The Fifth Committee then decided, by acclamation, to recommend the Auditor-General of Ghana for appointment as a member of the Board of Auditors for a three-year term beginning on 1 July 1979.

RECOMMENDATION OF THE FIFTH COMMITTEE

5. The Fifth Committee recommends that the General Assembly should appoint the Auditor-General of Ghana as a member of the Board of Auditors for a three-year term beginning on 1 July 1979.
