APPOINTMENTS TO FILL VACANCIES IN THE MEMBERSHIP
OF SUBSIDIARY ORGANS OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY

Investments Committee: confirmation of the appointments
made by the Secretary-General

Report of the Fifth Committee

1. At its 59th meeting on 13 December 1978, the Fifth Committee considered a note by the Secretary-General (A/33/124), in which he submitted for confirmation by the General Assembly the appointments as members of the United Nations Investments Committee, in accordance with the provisions of article 20 of the Regulations of the United Nations Joint Staff Pension Fund, for three-year terms beginning on 1 January 1979, of Mr. R. Manning Brown (reappointment), Mr. Jean Guyot (reappointment) and Mr. Toshio Shishido (reappointment). The Committee also had before it a note by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/33/93).
2. The Fifth Committee decided, without objection, to recommend to the General Assembly that it should confirm the appointments of Mr. R. Manning Brown, Mr. Jean Guyot and Mr. Toshio Shishido for three-year terms beginning on 1 January 1979.

RECOMMENDATION OF THE FIFTH COMMITTEE

3. The Fifth Committee recommends that the General Assembly should confirm the appointment by the Secretary-General of the following persons as members of the Investments Committee for a three-year term beginning on 1 January 1979:
