REVIEW OF INTERGOVERNMENTAL AND EXPERT MACHINERY DEALING
WITH THE FORMULATION, REVIEW AND APPROVAL OF PROGRAMMES
AND BUDGETS

Report of the Fifth Committee

Rapporteur: Mr. Peter G. BELYAEV (Byelorussian Soviet
Socialist Republic)

1. At the 5th plenary meeting, on 23 September 1977, the General Assembly decided to include in the agenda of its 32nd session the item entitled "Review of intergovernmental and expert machinery dealing with the formulation, review and approval of programmes and budgets" and to allocate it to the Fifth Committee.
2. At its 47th meeting, on 22 November, the Fifth Committee decided, without objection, to postpone its consideration of this item to the thirty-third session of the General Assembly.

Recommendation of the Fifth Committee

3. The Fifth Committee recommends that the General Assembly should decide to include in the provisional agenda of its thirty-third session the item entitled "Review of intergovernmental and expert machinery dealing with the formulation, review and approval of programmes and budgets".
