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LETTER DATED 23 JUNE 1989 FROM THE CHARGE D'AFFAIRES A.I. OF THE  
PERMANENT MISSION OF THE ISLAMIC REPUBLIC OF IRAN TO THE UNITED  
NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

Upon instructions from my Government and pursuant to my numerous letters concerning Iraqi violations of the cease-fire, I have the honour to submit a list of further violations of the cease-fire by Iraqi forces. The numerical sequences of these violations follow sequence of those previously reported.

1716. At 1800 hours on 11 May 1989, a new interconnecting canal was being dug in the vicinity of the geographic co-ordinates of QB 018-184 on the map of Mehran.

1717. On 11 May 1989, new canals were dug from the geographical co-ordinates of ND 788-817 to ND 788-812 on the map of Halabcheh.

1718. At 1900 hours on 13 May 1989, the Iraqis fired 42 120-millimetre flare bullets at the geographical co-ordinates of QV 3200-7800 on the map of Haddadieh Hills.

1719. On 13 May 1989, new fortifications were constructed at the geographical co-ordinates of MF 85-82 on the map of Seeparz Mountains (Beir Gim).

1720. On 13 May 1989, the Iraqis embarked on fortifying their positions by reconstructing old positions, constructing new barricades, and bringing in fresh reinforcements along the geographical co-ordinates of MF 874-886, MF 880-882, and MF 902-863 on the map of Seeparz (Beir Gim).

1721. On 14 May 1989, two battalions stationed along the area between the geographical co-ordinates of PD 950-910 and PD 869-068 on the map of Nowsud were replaced by fresh forces.

1722. On 14 May 1989, a machine gun position was constructed at the geographical co-ordinates of PB 748-138 on the map of Mehran.

1723. From 0230 to 0700 hours on 15 May 1989, two watch towers were being erected in the vicinity of the geographical co-ordinates of TQ 33-16 and TQ 32-17 on the map of Hoseinieh.

1724. At 1820 hours on 15 May 1989, four Iraqis were constructing observation posts in the vicinity of the geographical co-ordinates of QA 986-261 on the map of Dehloran and Nahr-e-Anbar.

1725. From 2000 to 2200 hours on 15 May 1989, bullets were fired with machine guns in the general area of Shalamcheh.

1726. At 0710 hours on 16 May 1989, some 22 Iraqis were digging underground barricades in the vicinity of the geographical co-ordinates of QA 985-262 on the map of Dehloran and Nahr-e-Anbar.

1727. At 0810 hours on 16 May 1989, an anti-aircraft unit was stationed at the geographical co-ordinates of QB 008-200 on the map of Dehloran.

1728. At 0820 hours on 16 May 1989, a new barricade was being dug in the vicinity of the geographical co-ordinates of QB 018-210 on the map of Dehloran.

1729. At 0820 hours on 16 May 1989, 15 Iraqis were digging new canals in the vicinity of the geographical co-ordinates of QB 018-210 on the map of Dehloran.

1730. From 0820 to 0950 hours on 16 May 1989, some 15 Iraqis were constructing new barricades in the vicinity of the geographical co-ordinates of QA 72-46 and QA 78-40 on the map of Einkhosh.

1731. At 0830 hours on 16 May 1989, some 15 Iraqis were digging interconnecting canals at the geographical co-ordinates of NC 687-483 on map No. 13.

1732. At 1700 hours on 16 May 1989, some 15 Iraqis were digging interconnecting canals at the geographical co-ordinates of NC 536-523 on the map of Nowsud.

1733. At 1800 hours on 16 May 1989, 30 Iraqis were unloading ammunition and installing a telephone line in a canal in the vicinity of the geographical co-ordinates of QB 019-314 on the map of Dehloran.

1734. At 1830 hours on 16 May 1989, five Iraqis were constructing new canals and repairing barbed wire lines in the vicinity of the geographical co-ordinates of TQ 32-17 on the map of Hoseinieh.

1735. On 16 May 1989, a new observation post was built in the vicinity at the geographical co-ordinates of QA 960-280 on the map Nahr-e-Anbar.

1736. At 0840 hours on 17 May 1989, transportation of ammunition was observed in the vicinity of the geographical co-ordinates of QB 018-200 on the map of Dehloran.

1737. From 1230 to 1810 hours on 17 May 1989, 15 Iraqis were constructing new barricades in the vicinity of the geographical co-ordinates of TQ 31-17 on the map of Hoseinieh.

1738. On 17 May 1989, new barricades were dug in the vicinity of the geographical co-ordinates of QB 021-189 on the map of Dehloran.

1739. In the evening of 17 May 1989, an 18-metre and a 40-metre canal were dug, respectively, at the geographical co-ordinates of NC 488-565 and NC 486-567 on the map of Sumar.

1740. At 0840 hours on 18 May 1989, a new observation post was built at the geographical co-ordinates of NC 730-533 on the map of Sumar.

1741. At 0920 hours on 18 May 1989, two Iraqis unloaded a machine gun and some ammunition at the geographical co-ordinates of ND 213-675 on the map of Ghasr-e-Shirin.

1742. At 1000 hours on 18 May 1989, a rest barricade was being constructed in the vicinity of the geographical co-ordinates of PB 767-153 on the map of Mehran.

1743. At 1300 hours on 18 May 1989, six Iraqis were installing barbed wires in the vicinity of the geographical co-ordinates of TQ 23-17 on the map of Hoseinieh.

1744. In the evening of 18 May 1989, three 15-metre, 25-metre and 20-metre interconnecting canals were dug, respectively, at the geographical co-ordinates of NC 487-566, NC 484-567 and NC 472-576 on the map of Sumar.

1745. On 18 May 1989, a landing area for helicopter was made at the geographical co-ordinates of NF 544-048 on the map of Piranshahr.

1746. On 18 May 1989, a new barricade was constructed at the geographical co-ordinates of PB 768-151 on the map of Mehran.

1747. At 1700 hours on 19 May 1989, eight Iraqis at the geographical co-ordinates of NC 527-528 and seven others at the geographical co-ordinates of NC 522-541 on the map of Sumar were digging two 10-metre interconnecting canals.

1748. In the evening of 19 May 1989, a 45-metre interconnecting canal was dug in the vicinity of the geographical co-ordinates of NC 482-570 on the map of Sumar.

1749. At 2245 hours on 20 May 1989, mines were being planted at the geographical co-ordinates of PB 738-132 on the map of Mehran.

1750. On 20 May 1989, new canals were dug at the geographical co-ordinates of NE 63-81 and NE 64-82 on the map of Baneh.

1751. On 20 May 1989, a new observation post was built at the geographical co-ordinates of NC 537-522 on the map of Sumar.
1752. At 0900 hours on 22 May 1989, two IFA vehicles discharged fresh reinforcements on the Kanisakht Heights at the geographical co-ordinates of PB 870-030 on the map of Saleh-Abad.
1753. At 1030 hours on 22 May 1989, six Iraqis were digging canals at the geographical co-ordinates of NC 060-950 on the map of Saleh-Abad.
1754. On 22 May 1989, an approximately 40-metre interconnecting canal was dug at the geographical co-ordinates of PB 815-108 on the map of Saleh-Abad.
1755. On 23 May 1989, a new observation barricade was built at the geographical co-ordinates of NC 240-790 on the map of Halaleh.
1756. In the evening of 23 May 1989, two 15-metre and 7-metre canals were dug, respectively, at the geographical co-ordinates of NC 527-538 and NC 532-534 on the map of Sumar. A 10-metre canal and an offensive barricade were made at the geographical co-ordinates of NC 516-537 on the same map.
1757. At 0820 hours on 24 May 1989, 11 Iraqis were repairing canals and barricades on Hill 654 at the geographical co-ordinates of ND 216-693 on the map of Ghal'eh.
1758. At 1500 hours on 24 May 1989, four new barricades were being constructed in the general area of Chamsari in the vicinity of the geographical co-ordinates of QA 862-382 on the map of Einkhosh.
1759. On 24 May 1989, the Iraqis reportedly occupied a new position at the geographical co-ordinates of NE 621-820 on the map of Baneh.
1760. By 24 May 1989, the Iraqis had been busy for several days reconstructing and consolidating their positions as well as constructing new barricades and bringing in fresh reinforcements in the strength of one brigade at the geographical co-ordinates of MF 88400-88600 and 88000-88200, and from MF 89-87 to MF 90200-86300 on the map of Seeparz Mountains.
1761. At 2100 hours on 25 May 1989, 20 flare bullets were fired from the vicinity of the geographical co-ordinates of NC 950-540 on the map of Kharrat-ha.
1762. By 27 May 1989, the Iraqis had been busy for several days building up a new trench with a bulldozer, erecting a group tent behind the trench, and transporting a great deal of materials to this position for constructing barricades at the geographical co-ordinates of NF 559-032 on the map of Piranshahr.

1763. On 28 May 1989, a new observation barricade and a new tank platform were built and an anti-aircraft cannon was stationed all along the geographical co-ordinates of TP 142-680 to TP 139-684 on the map of Nahr-e-Alishir.

1764. On 29 May 1989, three block barricades were constructed in the Karun area at the geographical co-ordinates of TP 694-272 and TP 690-276 on the map of Khorramshahr.

1765. On 29 May 1989, a new barricade was built at the geographical co-ordinates of TP 676-283 on the map of Khorramshahr.

1766. At 1100 hours on 30 May 1989, two new barricades were being built in the vicinity of the geographical co-ordinates of NC 518-522 on the map of Sumar.

1767. From 1150 to 1225 hours on 31 May 1989, a loader was excavating in the vicinity of the geographical co-ordinates of NC 708-505 on map No. 13.

1768. From 1455 to 1515 hours on 31 May 1989, a loader was excavating in the vicinity of the geographical co-ordinates of NC 708-497 on map No. 13.

1769. In the evening of 31 May 1989, two new barricades were built at the geographical co-ordinates of NC 284-638 on the map of Kani Sheikh.

1770. At 1840 hours on 1 June 1989, four Iraqis were constructing an offensive barricade in the vicinity of the geographical co-ordinates of NC 379-606 on the map of Sumar.

1771. At 1920 hours on 1 June 1989, a personnel carrier vehicle transported 15 soldiers from the geographical co-ordinates of NC 650-490 on map No. 13 to the vicinity of the geographical co-ordinates of NC 770-538 on the same map.

1772. On 1 June 1989, new canals were dug at the geographical co-ordinates of QB 015-212 on the map of Dehloran.

1773. On 2 June 1989, new canals were dug in the vicinity of the geographical co-ordinates of QA 27-44 on the map of Einkhosh.

1774. On 2 June 1989, new canals were dug at the geographical co-ordinates of ND 235-544 and ND 214-504 on the map of Ghasr-e-Shirin.

1775. On 2 June 1989, new canals were dug in the vicinity of the geographical co-ordinates of QA 892-261 on the map of Einkhosh, QA 832-351 on the map of Nahr-e-Anbar and QB 150-212, QB 011-152 and QB 018-222 on the map of Dehloran.

1776. On 3 June 1989, two helicopters were flying in the vicinity of the geographical co-ordinates of QA 35-61 and QA 37-61 on the map of Chazzabeh.

1777. On 3 June 1989, new tank platforms were built in the vicinity of the geographical co-ordinates of QA 915-022 on the map of Meimeh River.

1778. On 4 June 1989, a new barricade was built at the geographical co-ordinates of NE 64-86 on the map of Baneh.

1779. On 4 June 1989, a machine gun was stationed at the geographical co-ordinates of NF 0225-2930 on the map of Sardasht.

1780. On 4 June 1989, a new base was built at the geographical co-ordinates of PE 514-045 on the map of Marivan.

1781. On 4 June 1989, some 70 to 80 fresh forces were deployed at the geographical co-ordinates of MF 822-918 on the map of Seeparz Mountains.
