REPORT OF THE COMMITTEE ON CONTRIBUTIONS

Addendum

1. In paragraph 87 of its report to the General Assembly, the Committee on Contributions noted that eight Member States were in arrears in the payment of their assessed contributions to the expenses of the United Nations within the terms of Article 19 of the Charter and, in that connexion, authorized its Chairman to issue an addendum to its report should it be necessary.
2. The Secretary-General has now advised that, of the Member States listed in paragraph 87 of the Committee's report, the Dominican Republic, Haiti, Nicaragua and Paraguay have since made payments in sufficient amounts to reduce their arrears of assessed contributions below the limit prescribed by Article 19 of the Charter.
3. Thus, Member States which remain in arrears under the provisions of that Article are the Central African Empire, the Congo, Democratic Kampuchea and South Africa. In connexion with Democratic Kampuchea, attention is invited to paragraphs 88-90 of the Committee's report.
