LETTER DATED 23 MARCH 1984 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF THE REPUBLIC OF CAMEROON ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE CONFERENCE ON DISARMAMENT CONCERNING RULES 33 TO 35 OF THE RULES OF PROCEDURE
