

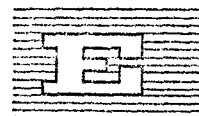

Note by the Secretary-General

In addition to the candidatures contained in document E/CN.4/1299 and Add.1 and 2, the Secretary-General has received nominations from the Government of the United Republic of Cameroon of the following names for inclusion in the updated list of experts in economic, sociological, legal and other relevant disciplines, whose advice would be available to States concerned with the liquidation of slavery and the slave trade in all their practices and manifestations, including the slavery-like practices of apartheid and colonialism: Mr. Marcel NGUINI, President of the Supreme Court, and Mr. François-Xavier MBOYOUUM, Procureur Général attached to the Supreme Court.
