The President: As this is the first meeting of the Security Council for the month of July 2009, I should like to take this opportunity to pay tribute, on behalf of the Council, to His Excellency Mr. Baki İlkin for his service, prior to his retirement as Permanent Representative of Turkey to the United Nations, as President of the Security Council for the month of June 2009. I am sure that I speak for all members of the Council in expressing deep appreciation to Ambassador İlkin for the great diplomatic skill with which he conducted the Council's business last month.

Adoption of the agenda

The agenda was adopted.

Letter dated 19 June 2009 from the Secretary-General addressed to the President of the Security Council (S/2009/333)

The President: The Security Council will now begin its consideration of the item on its agenda. The Council is meeting in accordance with the understanding reached in its prior consultations.

Members of the Council have before them document S/2009/339, which contains the text of a draft resolution submitted by Austria. Members also have before them document S/2009/333, which contains a letter dated 19 June 2009 from the Secretary-General addressed to the President of the Security Council.

It is my understanding that the Council is ready to proceed to the vote on the draft resolution before it. Unless I hear any objection, I shall now put the draft resolution to the vote.

There being no objection, it is so decided.

A vote was taken by show of hands.

In favour:

Austria, Burkina Faso, China, Costa Rica, Croatia, France, Japan, Libyan Arab Jamahiriya, Mexico, Russian Federation, Turkey, Uganda, United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland, United States of America, Viet Nam

The President: There were 15 votes in favour. The draft resolution has been adopted unanimously as resolution 1877 (2009).

The Security Council has thus concluded the present stage of its consideration of the item on its agenda. The Council will remain seized of the matter.

The meeting rose at 10.15 a.m.
