REPORT OF THE ECONOMIC AND SOCIAL COUNCIL

Letter dated 10 August 1977 from the representatives of France, the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and the United States of America to the United Nations addressed to the Secretary-General

We have the honour to refer to the letter dated 5 May 1977 from the Permanent Representative of the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics to the United Nations circulated on 5 May 1977 (A/32/79).

The Governments of France, the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and the United States of America do not accept the allegations contained in the Soviet note referred to above. They reaffirm the terms of their letter of 23 March 1976 to the Secretary-General (A/31/67) about the legality of the location in the western sectors of Berlin of the Federal Office for the Supervision of Cartels and Trusts and of the designation of a member of this Office as a member of the Federal Republic of Germany's delegation to the Commission on Transnational Corporations.

We ask you to circulate this letter as an official document of the General Assembly under item 12 of the provisional agenda.
