Letter dated 16 August 1977 from the Permanent Representative of
the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland to the
United Nations addressed to the Secretary-General

I have the honour to address Your Excellency in relation to the question of the Falkland Islands. In this connexion, and bearing in mind paragraph 5 of General Assembly resolution 31/49, I have pleasure in informing Your Excellency that, on the basis of the agreement expressed in the joint communiqué attached to the note addressed to Your Excellency on 8 June 1977 (A/32/111), representatives of the British and Argentine Governments met in Rome between 13 and 15 July and decided to meet again next November.

I request Your Excellency to arrange for this letter to be circulated as a document of the General Assembly under item 24 of the provisional agenda and brought to the attention of the Special Committee on Decolonization.
