Sudan:* draft resolution

Ad hoc panel on the world financial and economic crisis and its implications for development

The Economic and Social Council,

Mindful of paragraph 56 (e) of the Outcome of the Conference on the World Financial and Economic Crisis and Its Impact on Development,¹ in which the Economic and Social Council was requested to consider and make recommendations to the General Assembly regarding the possible establishment of an ad hoc panel of experts on the world economic and financial crisis and its impact on development,

1. *Decides*, in this regard, to undertake immediate consultations in order to make recommendations to the General Assembly at its sixty-third session;

2. *Also decides* to convene its 2009 resumed substantive session by 8 September 2009 for the purpose of adopting those recommendations;

3. *Requests* the Department of Economic and Social Affairs of the United Nations Secretariat to provide a detailed report by 20 August 2009, for consideration by the Economic and Social Council, on the terms of reference and experience of previous panels, including any other relevant features thereof.
