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Paragraph 17.1.7.1, amend to read (including a new footnote 4/):
"17.1.7.1. Notwithstanding the provisions of paragraph 17.1.7., motor vehicles of categories $\mathrm{M}_{2}$, $\mathrm{M}_{3}, \mathrm{~N}_{2}, \mathrm{~N}_{3}$ and $\mathrm{M}_{1}$ having either a maximum total mass $>3500 \mathrm{~kg}$ or a body type $\mathrm{SA}, \underline{4} /$ may be fitted with a heating system to heat the passenger compartment which is connected to the LPG-system.
