LETTER DATED 4 AUGUST 1989 FROM THE CHARGE D'AFFAIRES A.I. OF  
THE PERMANENT MISSION OF THE ISLAMIC REPUBLIC OF IRAN TO THE  
UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

Upon instruction from my Government, I have the honour to report a further violation by Iraq, not only of the provisions of the cease-fire but also of the established principles of International Law.

At 1:00 p.m. on 26 June 1989, an Iranian shepherd, Mr. Ibrahim Glandari was captured around Haji Ibrahim mountain in Piranshahr area and along with his 650 sheep was taken to Iraq.

According to UNIIMOG officials, the shepherd is taken to Baghdad, and the herd of sheep to behind the Iraqi positions.

Your Excellency is hereby requested to adopt necessary measures for the immediate release of the shepherd and return of his herd.

It would be highly appreciated if this note were circulated as a document of the Security Council.
