[11 July 1989]

1. On 8 July 1989, at 7.47 a.m. Moscow time, an underground nuclear explosion with a yield of up to 20 kilotons was conducted in the Soviet Union at a test site in the Semipalatinsk region.

2. The test was conducted with a view to refining military technology.

3. Radiation levels at the test area and outside the test site are normal.
