LETTER DATED 4 AUGUST 1989 FROM THE CHARGE D'AFFAIRES A.I. OF
THE PERMANENT MISSION OF THE ISLAMIC REPUBLIC OF IRAN TO THE
UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

Upon instructions from my Government and pursuant to my numerous letters concerning Iraqi violations of the cease-fire, I have the honour to submit a list of further violations of the cease-fire by Iraqi forces. The numerical sequences of these violations follows the sequence of those previously reported.

1864. On 8 June 1989, three tents were set up in the vicinity of the geographical co-ordinates of QB 005-153, QB 003-176, and QB 002-174 on the map of Dehloran.

1865. On 17 June 1989, a tank was moved from the vicinity of the geographical co-ordinates of QB 014-219 on the map of Dehloran to the vicinity of the geographical co-ordinates of QB 942-275 on the map of Nahr-e-Anbar.

1866. On 17 June 1989, two tanks were stationed in the vicinity of the geographical co-ordinates of QA 995-222 and QB 001-234 on the map of Dehloran.

1867. On 18 June 1989, a tank was moved from behind Hamrin Heights to the vicinity of the geographical co-ordinates of QB 014-224 on the map of Dehloran.

1868. On 19 June 1989, six Iraqis were constructing new barricades and deepening old canals at the geographical co-ordinates of NE 422-912 on the map of Panjwein.

1869. On 19 June 1989, a tank was stationed at the geographical co-ordinates of QB 920-320 on the map of Nahr-e-Anbar.

1870. On 21 June 1989, an 82-millimetre mortar launcher was stationed at the geographical co-ordinates of NE 651-849 on the map of Baneh.

1871. On 21 June 1989, a new barricade was built in the vicinity of the geographical co-ordinates of QA 80-40 on the map of Einkhosh.

1872. On 21 June 1989, a tank was stationed in the vicinity of the geographical co-ordinates of QA 863-362 on the map of Einkhosh.
1873. On 21 June 1989, an observation shelter was built in the vicinity of the geographical co-ordinates of NC 232-805 on the map of Halaleh.
1874. On 21 June 1989, Iraqi patrols entered the area in the vicinity of the geographical co-ordinates of ND 03-50 on the map of Kharrat-ha.
1875. On 21 June 1989, a new barricade was built at the geographical co-ordinates of PD 847-004 on the map of Nowsud.
1876. On 21 June 1989, four Iraqis were digging canals in the vicinity of the geographical co-ordinates of NC 255-770 on the map of Halaleh.
1877. On 21 June 1989, 10 tanks were deployed in the vicinity of the geographical co-ordinates of QA 862-262 on the map of Einkhosh.
1878. On 21 and 22 June 1989, two new barricades were built in the vicinity of the geographical co-ordinates of NC 255-770 on the map of Halaleh and ND 252-675 on the map of Ghasr-e-Shirin.
1879. On 22 June 1989, five Iraqis were digging new canals at the geographical co-ordinates of ND 252-675 on the map of Ghasr-e-Shirin.
1880. On 24 June 1989, new canals were dug at the geographical co-ordinates of NE 477-895 on the map of Panjwein.
1881. On 24 June 1989, seven Iraqis were digging new canals in the vicinity at the geographical co-ordinates of NE 422-913 on the map of Panjwein.
1882. On 24 June 1989, a four-barrel anti-aircraft was stationed at the geographical co-ordinates of QA 50-55 on the map of Yebeis.
1883. On 24 June 1989, new canals were dug at the geographical co-ordinates of QA 95-04 on the map of Meimeh and QA 67-49 on the map of Yebeis.
1884. On 24 June 1989, a new base was built at the geographical co-ordinates of MF 78-87 on the map of Siparuz Mountain.
1885. On 24 and 25 June 1989, 20 tents were erected at the geographical co-ordinates of NF 099-122 on the map of Ghal'eh Dizeh.
1886. On 24 and 25 June 1989, a new canal was dug in the vicinity of the geographical co-ordinates of NE 477-889 on the map of Panjwein.
1887. On 25 June 1989, a grader and 15 trucks were being moved to the geographical co-ordinates of TQ 31-18 on the map of Hoseinieh.

1888. On 25 June 1989, four trailers carrying tanks were moving towards the south from the geographical co-ordinates of QV 29-76 on the map of Haddadieh Hills.

1889. On 25 June 1989, three aircraft were flying, at high altitudes, to and from Marivan.

1890. On 25 June 1989, an unidentified aircraft was flying over the area in the vicinity of the geographical co-ordinates of NE 46-90 on the map of Panjwein.

1891. On 26 June 1989, 35 tents were set up at the geographical co-ordinates of NF 043-109 on the map of Ghal'eh Dizeh.

1892. On 26 June 1989, new canals were dug in the vicinity of the geographical co-ordinates of NF 64-87 on the map of Baneh.

1893. On 26 June 1989, an Iranian shepherd was captured in the area of Piranshahr and was taken, along with his 600 sheep, to Iraq.

1894. On 26 June 1989, 36 Iraqi vehicles were moving from Sharmani towards Mehran in the vicinity of the geographical co-ordinates of QA 935-032 on the map of Meimeh River.

1895. On 26 June 1989, the Iraqis were engaged in engineering activities in front of the front-lines at the geographical co-ordinates of TQ 325-175 on the map of Hoseinieh.

1896. On 26 June 1989, the Iraqis with an assortment of 150 vehicles entered the area in the vicinity of the geographical co-ordinates of QA 935-072 on the map of Meimeh River, and left the area after firing 70 flare bullets.

1897. On 26 June 1989, an unidentified aircraft was flying at high altitudes from the north towards south-west over the area in the vicinity of the geographical co-ordinates of NE 42-96 on the map of Marivan.

1898. On 27 June 1989, two new barricades were built in the vicinity of the geographical co-ordinates of QA 74-41 and QA 71-41 on the map of Einkhosh.

1899. On 27 June 1989, a helicopter made a sortie from the geographical co-ordinates of PE 61-30 to the PE 70-26 on the map of Mulan-Abad.

1900. On 27 June 1989, several group bunkers and observation posts were constructed and one Dushka cannon was stationed in the vicinity of the geographical co-ordinates of MF 829-975 and MF 828-911 on the map of Siparuz.

1901. On 27 June 1989, 10 new barricades were constructed at the geographical co-ordinates of NE 69-67 on the map of Garmah.

1902. On 28 June 1989, five Iraqis were digging canals at the geographical co-ordinates of QB 013-224 on the map of Dehloran.

1903. On 29 June 1989, new barricades were made and barbed wires were installed at the geographical co-ordinates of QV 27-65 on the map of West Jofeir.

1904. On 29 June 1989, two new canals were dug in the vicinity of the geographical co-ordinates of QB 004-232 on the map of Dehloran.

1905. On 29 June 1989, seven Iraqis were digging canals in the vicinity of the geographical co-ordinates of NE 62-72 on the map of Baneh.

1906. On 30 June 1989, a barricade and a firing position were constructed at the geographical co-ordinates of NE 650-965 on the map of Nanur.

1907. On 30 June 1989, 12 Iraqis dug a new canal in the vicinity of the geographical co-ordinates of NE 49-91 on the map of Marivan.

1908. On 30 June 1989, a machine-gun barricade was built in the vicinity of the geographical co-ordinates of QA 93-03 on the map of Meimeh.

1909. On 30 June and 1 July 1989, new barricades were built at the geographical co-ordinates of NE 842-908 on the map of Baneh.

1910. On 1 July 1989, four barricades were made and a 450-metre canal was dug at the geographical co-ordinates of NF 55-03 on the map of Piranshahr.

1911. On 1 July 1989, a watch tower was set up in the vicinity of the geographical co-ordinates of NE 489-916 on the map of Marivan.

1912. On 1 July 1989, four new barricades were made at the geographical co-ordinates of NF 709-640, NF 707-647, NF 702-642 and NF 705-642 on the map of Piranshahr.

1913. On 1 July 1989, a new canal was dug at the geographical co-ordinates of NE 812-375 on the map of Gak.

1914. On 1 July 1989, 20 new barricades were made and a 650-metre canal was dug at the geographical co-ordinates of NF 95-04 on the map of Piranshahr.

1915. On 1 July 1989, two new bases were made at the geographical co-ordinates of MF 76-87 and MF 78-87 on the map of Bir Gim.

1916. On 1 July 1989, six barricades were made and a 30-metre canal was dug at the geographical co-ordinates of NF 59-04 on the map of Piranshahr.

1917. On 1 July 1989, three bases were built at the geographical co-ordinates of MF 807-910 and MF 759-898 on the map of Siparuz.

1918. On 1 July 1989, a company of reinforcement was brought to Height 1770 in the vicinity of the geographical co-ordinates of NE 95-26 on the map of Sardasht.

1919. On 1 July 1989, four barricades were made and an 800-metre canal was dug at the geographical co-ordinates of NF 60-05 on the map of Piranshahr.

1920. On 1 July 1989, two new barricades were built in the vicinity of the geographical co-ordinates of QA 983-039 on the map of Kuh Tappeh.

1921. On 2 July 1989, a canal was dug at the geographical co-ordinates of NF 587-045 on the map of Piranshahr.

1922. On 2 July 1989, several group barricades were constructed at the geographical co-ordinates of MF 830-906 on the map of Siparuz.

1923. On 2 July 1989, four bases were constructed and one Dushka cannon and one mortar launcher were stationed at the geographical co-ordinates of NE 662-682 on the map of Baneh.

1924. On 2 July 1989, a new position was built at the geographical co-ordinates of MF 827-908 on the map of Siparuz.

1925. On 2 July 1989, two Iraqi aircraft were flying towards Iran from the vicinity of the geographical co-ordinates of NF 24-04 and NF 26-08 on the map of Seidan.

1926. On 2 and 3 July 1989, a stone wall was built up at the geographical co-ordinates of NE 495-918 on the map of Marivan.

1927. On 3 July 1989, new canals were dug at the geographical co-ordinates of NF 024-287 and NF 039-299 on the map of Sardasht.

1928. On 3 July 1989, a new barricade was built at the geographical co-ordinates of TQ 32-16 on the map of Hoseinieh.

1929. On 3 July 1989, a group tent was set up at the geographical co-ordinates of QB 005-185 on the map of Dehloran.

1930. On 4 July 1989, heavy engineering activities were observed at the geographical co-ordinates of MF 72-78 on the map of Siparuz.

1931. On 4 July 1989, three heavy weapons were stationed in the vicinity of Hill 75 at the geographical co-ordinates of QA 598-496 on the map of Yebeis.

1932. On 4 July 1989, new barricades were made in the vicinity of the geographical co-ordinates of QA 64-51 and QA 616-508 on the map of Yebeis.

1933. On 4 July 1989, a new barricade was made at the geographical co-ordinates of TQ 30-15 on the map of Hoseinieh.

1934. On 4 July 1989, a new stretch of canal was dug in the vicinity of the geographical co-ordinates of QA 88-37 on the map of Einkhosh.

1935. On 4 July 1989, stones were transported up on the mountain at the geographical co-ordinates of NF 028-288 on the map of Sardasht.
1936. From 5 to 6 July 1989, a new stretch of canal was dug in the vicinity of the geographical co-ordinates of QA 85-38 on the map of Einkhosh.
1937. From 5 to 6 July 1989, fresh reinforcements in the strength of 25 and 40 were brought to the vicinity of the geographical co-ordinates of NC 380-610 and NC 56-51 on the map of Sumar.
1938. On 7 July 1989, three tents were set up in the vicinity of the geographical co-ordinates of QB 002-239 on the map of Dehloran.
1939. On 8 July 1989, canals were dug and a new barricade was made at the geographical co-ordinates of NE 688-657 on the map of Garmab.
1940. On 8 July 1989, new canals were dug at the geographical co-ordinates of NE 822-622 on the map of Garmab.
1941. On 8 July 1989, a barricade and a canal were made at the geographical co-ordinates of NE 638-805 on the map of Baneh.
1942. On 8 July 1989, new bases were constructed at the geographical co-ordinates of NE 811-511 and NE 802-552 on the map of Garmab.
1943. On 8 July 1989, barricades were built at the geographical co-ordinates of NF 012-298, NF 008-263 and NF 028-267 on the map of Sardasht.
1944. On 9 July 1989, 12 Iraqis were building new fortifications at the geographical co-ordinates of NF 5467-0550 on the map of Piranshahr.
1945. On 9 July 1989, two Iraqi aircraft were flying from the south of Sardasht towards the north-east of this area.
1946. On 9 July 1989, two bulldozers were operating at the geographical co-ordinates of MF 750-855 on the map of Siparuz.
1947. On 9 July 1989, a stretch of canal was dug from the geographical co-ordinates of MF 822-912 to MF 828-908 on the map of Siparuz.
1948. On 9 July 1989, a new base was made at the geographical co-ordinates of NE 81-55 on the map of Garmab.
1949. On 9 July 1989, a truck and a trailer were unloading materials for constructing barricades at the geographical co-ordinates of MF 828-882 on the map of Siparuz.
1950. On 9 July 1989, Iraqis, employing heavy machinery, started constructing a wide road from the geographical co-ordinates of MF 85-86 to MF 82-89 on the map of Siparuz.

1951. On 10 July 1989, Iraqis were digging canals and building barricades along the area between the geographical co-ordinates of MF 82200-91200 and MF 82800-90800 on the map of Siparuz.

1952. On 10 July 1989, a tank was stationed at the geographical co-ordinates of QB 014-234 on the map of Dehloran.

1953. On 10 July 1989, a stretch of canal was dug in the vicinity of the geographical co-ordinates of QA 958-287 on the map of Nahr-e-Anbar.

1954. On 10 July 1989, a new barricade was built at the geographical co-ordinates of NE 488-912 on the map of Marivan.

1955. On 10 July 1989, the Iraqis forcefully moved to Iraq 1,500 sheep and their shepherds from the villages within the area of the geographical co-ordinates of NF 76-07, NF 75-03 and NF 76-01 on the map of Sarfian.

1956. On 11 July 1989, a new barricade was built at the geographical co-ordinates of NE 618-941 on the map of Nanur.

1957. On 11 July 1989, one 60-millimetre and one 120-millimetre mortar launchers were stationed at the geographical co-ordinates of NE 661-934 and NE 627-941 on the map of Nanur.

1958. On 11 July 1989, road constructions started in the general area of Haj Omran.

1959. On 11 July 1989, the Iraqis were building barricades and digging canals at the geographical co-ordinates of MF 813-912 and MF 829-908 on the map of Siparuz.

1960. On 11 July 1989, three bulldozers and two loaders were engaged in road construction activities at the geographical co-ordinates of MF 879-828 on the map of Siparuz.

1961. On 12 July 1989, two barricades were built at the geographical co-ordinates of QA 47-57 and QA 47-56 on the map of Yebeis.

1962. On 12 July 1989, a tank was stationed in the vicinity of the geographical co-ordinates of QB 012-214 on the map of Dehloran.

1963. On 14 July 1989, a defensive position was built at the geographical co-ordinates of NE 618-729 on the map of Baneh.
