IMPLEMENTATION OF THE DECLARATION ON THE GRANTING OF

Letter dated 1 December 1976 from the Permanent Representative of
Indonesia to the United Nations addressed to the President of the
General Assembly

With reference to the report of the Fifth Committee (A/31/366) relating, inter alia, to the administrative and financial implications of sending a visiting mission to East Timor, pursuant to operative paragraph 8 of the draft resolution adopted by the Fourth Committee as contained in its report (A/31/362, para 71, draft resolution IX), the Indonesian delegation has the honour to state its reservation regarding any financial allocation for the purpose of sending such a mission.

In this connexion, I should like to request you to inform the General Assembly of the above-mentioned reservation and that it be circulated as an official document of the thirty-first session of the General Assembly.
