REVIEW OF THE INTERGOVERNMENTAL AND EXPERT MACHINERY DEALING WITH THE FORMULATION, REVIEW AND APPROVAL OF PROGRAMMES AND BUDGETS

Report of the Fifth Committee

- 1. At its 4th plenary meeting, on 24 September 1976, the General Assembly decided to include in the agenda of its thirty-first session the item entitled "Review of the intergovernmental and expert machinery dealing with the formulation, review and approval of programmes and budgets" and to allocate it to the Fifth Committee.
- 2. At its 57th meeting, on 20 December, the Fifth Committee decided to recommend that consideration of this item should be postponed to the thirty-second session of the General Assembly.

RECOMMENDATION OF THE FIFTH COMMITTEE

3. The Fifth Committee recommends to the General Assembly that the item entitled "Financial emergency of the United Nations: report of the Negotiating Committee on the Financial Emergency of the United Nations" should be included in the provisional agenda of its thirty-second session.
