PROPOSED PROGRAMME BUDGET FOR THE BIENNIUM 1978-1979

Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions

Bangladesh, Egypt, Ghana, India, Indonesia, Kenya, Pakistan,
Panama, Sierra Leone, United Republic of Cameroon, United
Republic of Tanzania and Zambia: draft resolution

The General Assembly,

Recalling its resolution 14 (I) of 13 February 1946 on the establishment of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions and its resolutions 1659 (XVI) of 28 November 1961 and 2798 (XXVI) of 13 December 1971 on the expansion of the Committee,

Noting that the membership of the United Nations has increased substantially since the adoption of the resolutions expanding the Advisory Committee;

Desiring that the application of the principle of equitable geographical distribution should be strengthened by increased participation of developing countries in the Advisory Committee,

1. Decides to increase the membership of the Advisory Committee from 13 to 16 members to be effective from 1 January 1978;

2. Decides to make the appropriate amendments to the relevant rules of procedure.
