FINANCING OF THE UNITED NATIONS EMERGENCY FORCE AND
OF THE UNITED NATIONS DISENGAGEMENT OBSERVER FORCE

Draft resolution submitted by the Chairman

The Chairman, in consultation with the Secretariat, hereby submits the advance text of a draft resolution in order to enable the Secretary-General to enter into commitments for the United Nations Emergency Force and for the United Nations Disengagement Observer Force for the period 1 to 21 December 1976. The text of the proposed draft resolution is based on the text of resolution A/RES/31/5. It should be carefully noted, however, that unless and until the Security Council takes action to renew the mandate of UNDOF beyond 30 November 1976, the attached text is for information only. The Security Council has indicated that it intends to deal with this matter formally during the afternoon of Monday, 29 November 1976.

The General Assembly,

Recalling that the present authority of the Secretary-General to enter into commitments for the United Nations Emergency Force and for the United Nations Disengagement Observer Force, as provided by paragraph 1 of General Assembly resolution 31/5 of 26 October 1976, expires on 30 November 1976,

Taking note of Security Council resolution 396 (1976) of 22 October 1976, which renewed the mandate of the United Nations Emergency Force for the period from 25 October 1976 to 24 October 1977 inclusive, and of Security Council resolution ____ (1976) of ____ November 1976, which renewed the mandate of the United Nations Disengagement Observer Force for the period from 1 December 1976 to _____ inclusive,

1. Decides to authorize the Secretary-General to enter into commitments for the United Nations Emergency Force and for the United Nations Disengagement Observer Force at a rate not to exceed \$6,739,205 and \$1,393,607 per month, respectively, for the period from 1 to 21 December 1976 inclusive, in order to allow adequate time for consideration by the General Assembly of the report of the Secretary-General on the financing of the Forces;

2. Also decides to apportion the above-mentioned expenses among Member States in accordance with the scheme set forth in General Assembly resolutions 3374 B and C (XXX).
