## IMPLEMENTATION OF THE PROGRAMME FOR THE DECADE FOR ACTION TO COMBAT RACISM AND RACIAL DISCRIMINATION

### Treatment of immigrants

#### Draft decision proposed by India

The Commission on Human Rights decides

- (1) to request the Secretary-General to transmit to the thirty-second session of the Sub-Commission on the Prevention of Discrimination and Protection of Minorities the summary records of the thirty-fifth session of the Commission relating to the indignities and hardships suffered by non-white immigrants into the United Kingdom, resulting from racially discriminatory treatment by the concerned immigration authorities;
- (2) to request the Sub-Commission to examine this matter, and to transmit the result of its examination to the Commission at its thirty-sixth session;
- (3) to request Member States, the Government of the United Kingdom, as well as non-governmental organizations in consultative status with the Economic and Social Council, and relevant organizations within the United Nations system, such as ILO and WHO, to co-operate with the Sub-Commission in this study in all possible ways, including by sending to its next session whatever material is available with them on the subject.
