> QUESTION OF THE BEALIZATION IN ALL COUNTRIES OF THE ECONOMIC, SOCIAL AND CULTURAL RIGHTS CONTAINED IN THE UNIVERSAL DECLARATION OF HUMAN RIGHTS AND IN THE INTERNATIONAL COVENANT ON ECONOMIC, SOCIAL AND CULTURAL RIGHTS, AND STUDY OF SPECIAL PROBLEMS WHICH THE DEVELOPING COUNTRIES FACE IN THEIR EFFORTS TO ACHIEVE THESE HUMAN RIGHTS

Burundi, Cuba, India, Iraq, Nigeria, Panama, Peru, Syrian Arab Republic and Yugoslavia: draft resolution

The Commission on Human Rights,

<u>Recalling</u> that the United Nations Charter expresses the peoples determination to promote social progress and better standards of life in larger freedom,

<u>Recalling further</u> that it is a purpose of the United Nations, as expressed in Article I, paragraph 3 of its Charter, "to achieve international co-operation in solving international problems of an economic, social, cultural, or humanitarian character, and in promoting and encouraging respect for human rights and for fundamental freedoms for all without distinction as to race, sex, language, or religion",

<u>Bearing in mind</u> the Universal Declaration of Human Rights and especially article 25 which says that "everyone has the right to a standard of living adequate for the health and well-being of himself and of his family, including food, clothing, housing and medical care and necessary social services",

<u>Further bearing in mind</u> General Assembly resolution 3201 (S-VI) on the Declaration on the Establishment of a New International Economic Order, and resolution 3281 (XXX) on the Charter of Economic Rights and Duties of States,

<u>Taking note</u> of the Declaration of the Ministers of Foreign Affairs of the Mon-Aligned Countries in Line on 30 August 1975 and the Declaration of the Ministers of Foreign Affairs of the Non-Aligned Countries in Belgrade, 1978,

Recalling its recolution 4 (XXXIII) of 21 February 1.977,

Taking into account especially General Assembly resolution 32/130 of 16 December 1977,

Noting the importance of the provisions of the International Covenant on Economic, Social and Cultural Rights, GE.79-10980
