Syrian Arab Republic: draft resolution

The Commission on Human Rights,

1. Expresses its profound satisfaction to the Government of Iran, which has recently severed all relations with the racist régime in South Africa and has, in particular, stopped all oil supplies to that régime, thereby contributing substantially to the struggle against apartheid and racism;
2. Takes this opportunity to thank and congratulate all other Governments which have already adopted measures similar to those recently taken by the Government of Iran.
