The meeting was called to order at 11 a.m.

AGENDA ITEM 55: REPORT OF THE SPECIAL COMMITTEE TO INVESTIGATE ISRAELI PRACTICES AFFECTING THE HUMAN RIGHTS OF THE POPULATION OF THE OCCUPIED TERRITORIES (A/33/356, A/33/369)

1. The CHAIRMAN said that the representative of Sri Lanka, who was to introduce the report of the Special Committee (A/33/356), had asked the Special Political Committee to allow him more time for that purpose. Since there were only two speakers on the list in addition to the representative of Sri Lanka, he suggested that the meeting should be suspended until the afternoon. He also suggested that the list of speakers should be closed at the end of the meeting to be held on Tuesday afternoon, 21 November, and that the deadline for submitting draft resolutions should be the end of the meeting to be held on Wednesday morning, 22 November. If he heard no objection, he would take it that the Committee agreed to those suggestions.

2. It was so decided.

The meeting was suspended at 11.05 a.m.
