Cuba: draft telegram to the Government of Guatemala

The Commission on Human Rights, meeting at Geneva at its thirty-fifth session, took note of the assassination on 25 January 1979 of Dr. Alberto Fuentes Mohr, a deputy, a former Minister for Foreign Affairs and Finance and a former member of the United Nations Secretariat. The Commission expresses its profound concern at this assassination and urges the Government of Guatemala to take all necessary steps to arrest, try and punish those who are guilty of it. In addition, it requests the Government of Guatemala for information on the matter before the opening of its thirty-sixth session.
