> QUESTION OF THE HUMAN RIGHTS OF ALL PERSONS SUBJECTED TO ANY FORM OF DETENTION OR IMPRISONMENT

The Commission on Human Rights,

<u>Recalling</u> resolution 33/173 of the General Assembly, requesting the Commission on Human Rights to consider the question of disappeared persons with a view to making appropriate recommendations,

<u>Seriously concerned</u> at reports concerning the situation and number of missing and disappeared persons in Argentina,

Noting with appreciation that the Government of Argentina has invited the Inter-American Commission on Human Rights to visit Argentina during the next months with regard to the human rights situation;

 <u>Invites</u> the Government of Argentina to inform the Commission through the Sub-Commission on Prevention of Discrimination and Protection of Minorities of steps it is taking to resolve the problem of missing and disappeared persons;
<u>Requests</u> the Secretary-General to submit to the Commission at its thirty-sixth session through the Sub-Commission an analytical summary of information he has received on the question of missing and disappeared persons in Argentina.
