

Opening of the session

Election of officers

At the beginning of its thirty-first session, the Committee elected a Chairperson, three Vice-Chairpersons and a Rapporteur to serve for the subsequent two years. The position of one of the Vice-Chairpersons fell vacant at the end of 2009 following the departure of Irakli Chikovani (Georgia) from the Permanent Mission of Georgia to the United Nations. At the beginning of its thirty-second session, the Committee will elect a Vice-Chairperson to replace him for the remainder of the term.
