Sir:

I have the honour to refer to the fact that at its First Session the Economic and Social Council appointed representatives to undertake negotiations with the inter-governmental organizations to be brought into relationship with the United Nations, in pursuance of the duties laid upon the Council under Articles 57 and 63 of the Charter of the United Nations.

The President of the Economic and Social Council has authorized me to invite the Trusteeship Council to nominate three representatives to join the representatives of the Economic and Social Council in negotiations of this kind which will be undertaken henceforth with respect to clauses concerning the Trusteeship Council. I should be grateful if you would bring this letter to the notice of the Council in connection with Item 11 on the agenda.
