ADMISSION OF NEW MEMBERS TO THE UNITED NATIONS

Letter dated 16 August 1976 from the President of the Security Council
to the Secretary-General

I have the honour to request you to transmit to the General Assembly the following resolution (resolution 394 (1976)) on the admission of the Republic of Seychelles to membership in the United Nations, adopted by the Security Council at its 1952nd meeting, on 16 August 1976:

"The Security Council,

"Having examined the application of the Republic of Seychelles for admission to membership in the United Nations, 1/

"Recommends to the General Assembly that the Republic of Seychelles be admitted to membership in the United Nations."

In accordance with rule 60, paragraph 2, of the provisional rules of procedure, I also request you to transmit to the General Assembly, for its information, the verbatim records of the 1951st and 1952nd meetings of the Security Council, at which the application of the Republic of Seychelles was discussed.
