Re: BELAU - United States of America trusteeship

I understand your Council will be reviewing the above trusteeship within the next few months.

In view of the use of the Territory by the United States for its own military purposes and its refusal to accept the wish of the local people for a true and lasting independence, it is my view and that of many Australians, that the United States has not carried out the obligations of its trusteeship which should therefore be terminated.
