

Proposal for Supplement 1 to the 06 series of amendments to Regulation No. 16

Submitted by the experts from Belgium and Germany*

The text reproduced below was prepared by the experts from Belgium and Germany in order to introduce prescriptions for side-facing seats in vehicles of category M₃ (Class II, III and B). This proposal supersedes GRSP-46-15, distributed during the forty-sixth session of the Working Party on Passive Safety (GRSP). The modifications to the current text of the Regulation are marked in bold or strikethrough characters.

I. Proposal

Insert new paragraphs 2.18.2. to 2.18.4., to read:

- "2.18.2. "Forward-facing seat" means a seat which can be used whilst the vehicle is in motion and which faces towards the front of the vehicle in such a manner that the vertical plane of symmetry of the seat forms an angle of less than $+10^{\circ}$ or -10° with the vertical plane of symmetry of the vehicle.
- 2.18.3. "Rearward-facing seat" means a seat which can be used whilst the vehicle is in motion and which faces towards the rear of the vehicle in such a manner that the vertical plane of symmetry of the seat forms an angle of less than $+10^{\circ}$ or -10° with the vertical plane of symmetry of the vehicle.
- 2.18.4. "Side-facing seat" means a seat which can be used whilst the vehicle is in motion and which faces towards the side of the vehicle in such a manner that the vertical plane of symmetry of the seat forms an angle of 90° (\pm 10°) with the vertical plane of symmetry of the vehicle."
