The meeting was called to order at 11.40 a.m.

Agenda item 5: Election of the officers of the Main Committees

- 1. **The Chairman** recalled that in accordance with rule 99 (a) of the rules of procedure, as amended by General Assembly resolutions 56/509, paragraph 2 (c), and 58/126, annex B, paragraph 9, all the Main Committees were required to elect a chairman and a full bureau at least three months before the opening of the session.
- 2. Ms. Picco (Monaco) had been nominated for election to the office of Chairman for the sixty-fifth session. In the absence of further nominations and in accordance with rule 103 of the rules of procedure, he would take it that the Committee wished to elect Ms. Picco (Monaco) Chairman.
- 3. Ms. Picco (Monaco) was elected Chairman by acclamation.
- 4. **Ms. Picco** (Monaco) thanked the Group of Western European and Other States for nominating her and the Committee for electing her. As Chairman, she would work with the Bureau and the Office of Legal Affairs to strengthen the rule of law and promote international law.
- 5. **The Chairman** said that the Group of African States, the Group of Asian States and the Group of Eastern European States had nominated, respectively, Mr. Nega (Ethiopia), Mr. Park Chull-joo (Republic of Korea) and Ms. Šurková (Slovakia) for the posts of Vice-Chairmen.
- 6. Mr. Nega (Ethiopia), Mr. Park Chull-joo (Republic of Korea) and Ms. Šurková (Slovakia) were elected Vice-Chairmen.
- 7. **The Chairman** said that the election of the Rapporteur, to be nominated by the Group of Latin American and Caribbean States, would be held at a later date.
