## **Enlargement of the Executive Committee of the Programme of the United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees**

## The General Assembly,

*Taking note* of Economic and Social Council decision 2010/246 of 22 July 2010 concerning the enlargement of the Executive Committee of the Programme of the United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees,

Taking note also of the request regarding the enlargement of the Executive Committee contained in the note verbale dated 9 September 2009 from the Permanent Mission of Cameroon to the United Nations addressed to the Secretary-General,<sup>1</sup> the note verbale dated 23 October 2009 from the Permanent Mission of Togo to the United Nations addressed to the Secretariat,<sup>2</sup> the note verbale dated 27 October 2009 from the Permanent Mission of Bulgaria to the United Nations addressed to the Secretary-General,<sup>3</sup> the letter dated 9 February 2010 from the Permanent Representative of Turkmenistan to the United Nations addressed to the Secretary-General<sup>4</sup> and the letter dated 19 May 2010 from the Permanent Representative of Croatia to the United Nations addressed to the Secretary-General,<sup>5</sup>

1. *Decides* to increase the number of members of the Executive Committee of the Programme of the United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees from seventy-nine to eighty-four States;

2. *Requests* the Economic and Social Council to elect the additional members at its resumed organizational session for 2011.
