## Summary statement by the Secretary-General on matters of which the Security Council is seized and on the stage reached in their consideration

## Addendum

Pursuant to rule 11 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council and in accordance with the note by the President dated 26 July 2010 (S/2010/507), the Secretary-General is submitting the following summary statement.

The last list of items of which the Security Council is seized and which have been considered by the Council at a formal meeting since 1 January 2007 is contained in document S/2010/10/Add.35. The list of items of which the Council is seized which have not been considered at a formal meeting since 1 January 2007 is contained in document S/2010/10/Add.9.
